

REGULAR MEETING

The Fairbank City Council met in regular session on Monday, September 25, 2017. Mayor Cowell called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Members present: Miller, Vorwald, Harter, Woods and Mangrich. Nays: None. Also present: Dave Ryan, Public Works Director; Jonathan Kono, Public Works; Rick Deitrick, Police Chief; Marlene Strempeke, City Clerk and Brittany Annis, Deputy Clerk.

Motion by Harter, second by Miller to approve the agenda as presented. Roll call vote—Ayes: Harter, Miller, Mangrich, Vorwald and Woods. Nays: None.

Motion by Vorwald, second by Miller to approve the minutes of the September 9th regular meeting. Roll call vote—Ayes: Vorwald, Miller, Woods, Harter and Mangrich. Nays: None.

Lucas Elsbernd from Fehr Graham Engineering and three Iowa Regional Utilities Association employees were present to discuss the alternatives available to supply the city with water with the seven community residents in attendance. Another public informational meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 3rd at 6:00 P.M. when a decision on which way to go will be made.



Kevin Bodensteiner was present to inform the council of the \$40,000 grant they had just received to purchase a new automatic lift cot which will make it easier and safer to load patients and that the new fire truck will be ready to be picked up later in October. He also informed the council of the training they have conducted and the EMT classes that are coming up and the recruitment of individuals interested.

Black Hawk Waste Disposal will be contacted to see if a city wide clean-up day can be set up for some time during the third week of October.
