

ORDINANCE NO. 350

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FAIRBANK, IOWA, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of Fairbank, Iowa:

SECTION 1. SECTION MODIFIED. Section 74.07, subsection 4 and 5, and 74.09 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fairbank, Iowa, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

74.07 PERMIT.

4. All permits shall be issued for a specific vehicle. Permit holders will be issued a number and will be given a license sticker and is must be affixed to vehicle on the left side rear fender or similar component.
5. The initial fee for such permits shall be thirty dollars (\$30.00). Permits will be granted for one (1) year valid from January 01 through December 31. Permits may be purchased at any time during the year but will be valid only through December 31. Once a person has purchased a permit, they can renew their permit annually for a renewal fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00). All permit licenses are transferable to a new unit upon proper inspection and updated permit information.

74.09 TIME OF OPERATION. All vehicles governed by this chapter may be operated on city streets only between the hours of 5 AM and 10 PM.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
