

REGULAR MEETING

The Fairbank City Council met in regular session on Monday, September 28, 2015. Mayor Cowell called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:00 P.M. Members present: Woods, Vorwald, Mangrich and Erickson. Absent: Robinson. Also present: Dave Ryan, Public Works Director; David Hosack, City Attorney; Brittany Annis, Deputy Clerk and Marlene Strempeke, City Clerk.

Motion by Woods, second by Mangrich to amend the agenda to include Walnut Street South and Intersection of Fifth Street and East Main Street Repair. Roll call vote—Ayes: Woods, Mangrich Vorwald and Erickson. Nays: None.

Motion by Woods, second by Mangrich to approve the amended agenda. Roll call vote—Ayes: Woods, Mangrich, Vorwald and Erickson. Nays: None.

Motion by Vorwald, second by Woods to approve the minutes of the September 14th regular meeting and the September 16th special meeting. Roll call vote—Ayes: Vorwald, Woods, Erickson and Mangrich. Nays: None.

Motion by Erickson, second by Mangrich to hire a reserve police officer as set forth in Iowa Code Chapter 80D. He would need to comply with the training requirements set forth in the Code and would be covered by the city's workers' compensation and liability insurance. He would be paid \$1.00 per year to start, which could be changed. Attorney Hosack recommended that a formal employment agreement be drawn up with Mr. Sander. Roll call vote—Ayes: Erickson, Mangrich, Vorwald and Woods. Nays: None.

Motion by Vorwald, second by Woods to place yield signs at the intersections of Amy Avenue and Collins Road and Amy Avenue and Christians Trail. An ordinance modification will be prepared for approval at the next meeting. Roll call vote—Ayes: Vorwald, Woods, Erickson and Mangrich. Nays: None.


Motion by Mangrich, second by Vorwald to hire Caleb Kruger to replace the roof on the ballpark shelter. It is hoped that enough volunteers can be found to help put a windbreak on the north side and part of the west side of the shelter. Estimated cost of the project is \$5,400. Roll call vote—Ayes: Mangrich, Vorwald, Woods and Erickson. Nays: None.

Motion by Vorwald, second by Erickson to begin removal of the silt on the north of the island in late October or early November. It is hoped that volunteer labor will keep the cost down. No definite decision had been made on where the dirt will be taken as several possibilities are being considered. Roll call vote—Ayes: Vorwald, Erickson and Mangrich. Nays: None. Abstain: Woods.

Motion by Woods, second by Vorwald to repair the intersection of Fifth Street and East Main Street and as much of Walnut Street South as can be completed with available funds. Roll call vote—Ayes: Woods, Vorwald, Mangrich and Erickson. Nays: None.

Motion by Mangrich, second by Erickson to adjourn at 6:50 P.M. Roll call vote—Ayes: Mangrich, Erickson, Woods and Vorwald. Nays: None.
