### **Collection Guidelines**

- 1. Have Garbage & Recycling at the curb by 7:00a.m. on Monday (Holiday Collection is the next day)
- 2. One 65 gallon, or two 33 gallon garbage containers a week is allowed.
- 3. You may have an unlimited amount of recycled material.
- 4. Use city provided recycling container.
- 5. ALL material must be in a container with a closed lid.
- 6. City Waste and Recycling Collection is for city residents only. Please do not bring friends and relatives waste into the city for disposal.

These Guidelines Are to Increase Recycling, and Save Money!

#### Questions/Answers

- Q: I do not have very much garbage. Can I place a small bag at the curb?
- A: Animals and wind have cause waste to blow about, so all material must be secured in a container.

  You may use as small of a container as needed.
- Q: I live alone and the recycling containers are large. Do I have to use the large container?
- A: We suggest that you keep recycling until it is full. It is not necessary to put recycling out every week.
- Q: recycling is a hassle. How does recycling affect me?
- A: The cost for material that goes to the land fill is more than three times per ton than material sent to the recycling center. As the cost of doing business rises, we must find alternatives to combat rising cost.

### **Recycling Containers**
